


Misty the Cloud

About the Book

When Misty's party with her cloud pals is interrupted by Raye and her sunbeam friends, Misty goes from cool and calm to a bit heated. The clouds and sunbeams have a very hard time putting aside their differences and agreeing on a game.

But when they do finally find a way to come together, they all make something beautiful: a big rainbow!

This new addition to the Misty the Cloud series teaches students about compromise and sharing, and dealing with good days, bad days, and everything in between.

Before Reading

Have a discussion with students that touches on these questions:

- Have you ever had a fight with a friend?
- Have you ever made up with a friend after a fight?
- What did you do to make up?
- What is a compromise?

During Reading

Discuss with students:

- What is the problem in the story?
- How do the characters make up?

After Reading

Asks students to work **in pairs** to draw a rainbow on the handout page. Because this is a partner activity, work should be evenly divided. Before beginning the assignment, review the self-grading rubric at the bottom of the page with students. After students complete the drawing, ask them to reflect on how they worked together.
